



SUPPORT OF THE NATIONAL



The **Solidarity Fund's** support to the **vaccination programme** focused on:

Supporting the strengthening of vaccination teams and rural outreach

Supporting vaccine rollout - 'taking the vaccine to the people'

Amathole districts resulted in over 500.000 additional jabs being administered in the rural and deep rural Eastern Cape subdistricts. Our National Vaccine Coordination, Technical Assistance and Capacitation Programme led by DGMT contributed to the deployment of over 200 technical assistants to the NDoH, Provincial Departments of Health and districts. The individuals provided much needed assistance to the otherwise strained various **Health Department resources** with respect to coordinating and managing the pandemic and the national roll out that resulted in over **39,7 million people (50.6%)** being vaccinated.

FLOODS RESPONSE UPDATE

In May 2022 the Solidarity Fund announced that it had initiated the important work of planning, allocating and disbursing funds to those in need in the flood-affected regions of KZN and Eastern Cape. To date, over R45 million in donor funding was received, with R35,6 million in grant funding for KZN projects disbursed by early June. Tents pitched by KZNCC outside Ntuzuma community hall


HCRF FOOD RELIEF RESPONSE: **DSD AND PHTL FOOD RELIEF PROGRAM** Access to **food** and **water** is a fundamental human right, and the impact of the **July** 2021 riots affected the accessibility to food in certain areas across KZN and Gauteng. Through the collaborative efforts of the Humanitarian Crisis Relief Fund, the Department of Social Development and the KwaZulu-Natal Provincial House of **Traditional Leaders**, a **food parcel project** to provide access to **food** to those affected by the civil unrest was established.
